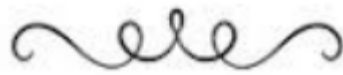

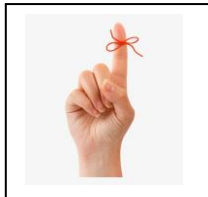

North Carolina's Safe Surrender Law allows a parent to surrender a newborn up to seven days old to a *responsible adult* without the parent providing his or her name. Safe Surrender is legal and aims to prevent newborns from being hurt or abandoned. Do your best to make sure that the baby is healthy, warm and clean. Then find a responsible adult who will assist you with the surrender of your newborn. Your best options for a Safe Surrender contact include: health care provider, law enforcement officer, social services worker, emergency medical personnel.
